IPCC Frontline

Production of New TV Drama in Full Swing



監警會製作了一套四集的《監警最前線》電視劇集,透過真實投訴個案改編的故事,介紹監警會的職能和會方在投訴警察制度中所發揮的作用。 Production of IPCC's new four-episode TV drama series, IPCC Frontline, was in full swing. Adopted from real complaint cases, these stories featured the statutory functions and the role of the IPCC in the complaints handling system.

獨立監察警方處理投訴委員會(監警會)一直致力透過不同的宣傳渠道與持份者保持聯繫,加深大眾對會方職能及兩層架構投訴警察制度的認識。監警會早於2015年製作的電視劇集《監警有道》廣獲好評,曾入選「2015電視節目欣賞指數調查(第二階段)」排名最高的20個節目之一。時至今日,仍有不少觀眾透過監警會及香港電台YouTube頻道重溫劇集。相隔六年,全新一輯電視劇集《監警最前線》即將與觀眾見面。

The Independent Police Complaints Counci (IPCC) has been proactively engaging with stakeholders through various promotional channels to enhance public understanding of its functions and the two-tier police complaints system. The 2015 IPCC TV series named *IPCC Files* received widespread public acclaim and was among the top 20 of the "2015 TV Programme Appreciation Index Survey (2nd stage)". Nowadays, viewers are still revisiting the *IPCC Files* through the YouTube Channels of IPCC and RTHK. Six years later, a whole new TV series named *IPCC Frontline* will be launched soon.

真實投訴改編 展現投訴處理全貌

《監警最前線》的籌備工作於去年底展開,會方特別挑選貼近日常生活的投訴個案,例如交通執法、截停搜查等投訴個案為劇集藍本,向公眾展示兩層架構投訴警察制度的運作,以及監警會委員、觀察員及秘書處審核團隊日常工作的點滴。會方的宣傳及意見調查委員會全程緊密監督劇本編寫、選角及拍攝過程,以確保《監警最前線》能將監警會工作最真實的一面展現在觀眾眼前。

經過數月的籌備工作,劇集於今年三月正式開拍。拍攝首天,時任監警會主席梁定邦博士、宣傳及意見調查委員會主席陳錦榮先生、委員動查委員會主席陳錦榮先生、委員 第女士、朱永耀先生、李曉華女士、楊華勇先生、余黎青萍女士、陳美寶女士以及署理秘書書 生、余黎青萍女士、陳美寶女士以及署理秘書書 時主及一眾委員亦在場觀摩拍攝情況,並與演員們分享擔任委員的工作點滴,讓他們在演繹相關角色時更得心應手,將監警會的真實面貌呈現給觀眾。

Real cases adopted to unveil the complaint handling process

Preparatory work for *IPCC Frontline* commenced at the end of 2020. Complaint cases pertinent to daily life, such as traffic enforcement, stop and search, etc., were selected by the IPCC as the blueprint for each episode. The brand new *IPCC Frontline* illustrates the operation of the two-tier police complaints system and offers the audience a glimpse of the daily work of IPCC Members, Observers and the Secretariat vetting teams. The Publicity and Survey Committee (PSC) has closely overseen the entire script-writing, casting and filming processes to ensure that the TV drama could best showcase the real-life operation of the IPCC to the audience.

After months of preparation, filming of the new TV series began in March this year. Dr Anthony Francis Neoh (the then Chairman of the IPCC), Mr Clement Chan Kam-wing (Chairman of PSC), Council Members Ms Ann Au Chor-kwan, Mr Alex Chu Wing-yiu, Miss Sylvia Lee Hiu-wah, Mr Johnny Yu Wah-yung, Mrs Helen Yu Lai Ching-ping and Miss Mabel Chan Mei-bo, Acting Secretary-General Mr Daniel Mui and the main cast officiated at a kick off ceremony on the first day of filming. Dr Neoh and Council Members observed the filming and shared their experience working at the Council with the main cast to facilitate their performance and help them present the truest picture of the IPCC to the public.

New TV series to be launched soon

IPCC Frontline focuses on introducing key work of the Council, such as the evidentiary threshold for complaint cases, the operation of the two-tier police complaints system, work procedures of the Council Members and the Secretariat, division of work and interaction between the Council and the Complaints Against Police Office (CAPO), collection of evidence, the role of Observers, etc. Through camera lens and the fantastic interpretation of the cast, the audience will be shown the IPCC's work from various perspectives.

During filming, the cast reflected that they were most impressed by the "first hand" experience on how the IPCC examined complaint investigation reports thoroughly from different perspectives and made improvement recommendations to the Police. IPCC's follow-up with the Police on recommendations in its Thematic Study Report

Examination of enhancements to the 999 Console

The IPCC put forward a series of recommendations in relation to the enhancement of 999 Console in coping with extreme stress to the Police in its Thematic Study Report on the large-scale public order events in 2019 (the Report), and has been closely following up on the implementation progress of these recommendations. Accompanied by Ms Rebecca Lam Hiu-tong, Director of Management Services of Hong Kong Police Force, Ms Anna Tsang Yim-sheung, Assistant Commissioner of Police (Service Quality) and representatives of the Complaints Against Police Office (CAPO), the IPCC delegation examined various enhancements made to the 999 Console as well as manpower deployment and studied how such improvements can fully prepare the Force to handle emergency situations. CAPO also invited representatives of the Security Bureau to review the implementation of improvement measures.

In the course of examining the complaint cases in connection with the Yuen Long incident occurred on 21 July 2019, the IPCC observed that 75% of the allegations were related to the Police's handling of 999 emergency calls or calls to Report Rooms at various police stations, such as failure to answer calls in time during system overflow. Therefore, the Report put forward recommendations to address deficiencies in coping with extreme stress. The visit allowed the Council to understand the enhancements made, which included (1) installation of new pre-recorded telephone messages to apprise callers in the waiting queue of instant information, (2) implementation of an Overflow Mechanism which allows the overflow calls to be taken by other Districts or Regions, (3) installation of additional 999 receiving stations at Divisional Consoles, and (4) formulation of a Regional Command and Control Centre Cadre comprising divisional officers who have Console duty experience to provide support when necessary.

It is believed that these systemic enhancements will effectively facilitate the Police in meeting challenges arising from their work and preventing recurrence of similar complaints. The IPCC attaches great importance to the examination of complaint cases and the study of complaint trends with a view to offering improvement recommendations to the Police in a timely manner. In the long run, these recommendations will be conducive to enhancing Police service quality, which will in turn further strengthen trust between the Force and the general public."

卸任感言

A Message from the Outgoing Chairman



梁定邦博士,QC,SC,JP Dr Anthony Francis NEOH, QC, SC, JP

2018年5月,政府甫宣布委任我為監警會主席,一名記者旋即寄來電郵,詢問我會否覺得自己擔當此職有大材小用之嫌。我當時如此回覆:「服務公眾,哪有大材小用這回事。我們必須以極其謙卑的態度和服務精神對待所有公職。」如今回望,我很高興自己當時如是説。

持不同意見者互相交火,擔任公職者永遠無法置身事外。然而,自2019年6月12日以來所發生的極端狀況,卻遠遠超乎我的預期。更令人惶恐的是,當時形勢極為嚴峻,以往公職積累的經驗完全無法派上用場。

自2019年6月12日起,反對聲音於本港社會深深植根, 引發街頭暴力事件、公共財產遭受嚴重破壞,無辜人 士受到傷害。警隊肩負維護法紀之責,需要使用相稱 的武力遏止暴力,平息動亂。然而縱觀全球各地,每 每執法人員使用武力,難免會捲起指責「警暴」的討 伐聲浪,香港亦不例外。社交媒體被當作激發更強烈 動亂和暴力行為的主要平台。正當「警暴」指控甚囂 塵上之際,自製不同武器及汽油彈的方法亦同時在網 上廣泛流傳,甚至在全無真憑實據下含沙射影指控警 察殺人。

商舗、餐廳、港鐵及其他公共財產屢遭破壞。九龍區主要幹道 — 彌敦道上所有交通燈一概遭到損毀。一連數月,車輛及行人凡途經彌敦道及周遭各大小十字路口時,莫不小心翼翼,以免發生碰撞或受傷。在街上呼籲停止暴力的人遭到毆打,一名男子更被磚頭擊中死亡,亦有人被淋潑火水後點火,造成三級燒傷,終身殘障。也有市民在社交媒體上成為攻擊目標,個人資料被曝光,即網上俗稱的「起底」,不少警務人員和表達温和意見的公眾人物均受牽連。當時,監警會亦陷入這個暴力漩渦中。

In May 2018, soon after the Government announced my appointment as Chairman of the IPCC, a reporter sent me an email to ask if I had thought that I was overqualified for the position. My answer was as follows: "No one is ever 'over qualified' for public service; one must treat any public office with a deep sense of humility and service." Looking back, I am glad I said this.

A person in public office is never far from the crossfire of opposing views. But the extreme circumstances which developed from June 12, 2019, far exceeded my expectations. And, to my horror, I found that nothing in my previous experience in public service had prepared me for the dire situation in front of me.

From June 12, 2019, opposing views in Hong Kong society became deeply entrenched, leading to violence in the streets, much destruction of public property, and innocent people were injured. As the legal custodians of law and order, the Police had to use proportionate force to quell the violence and civil unrest. As is the case worldwide, any resort to using force in law enforcement would generally bring forth shrill cries of "police brutality." Hong Kong was no exception to this phenomenon. Social media became the main arena for the battle cry for more civil unrest and more violence. Plans for making sundry weapons and Molotov cocktails freely circulated in social media amid accounts of alleged police brutality. There were even allegations of killings by the Police with nothing more than innuendos to support the claim.

Shops, restaurants, the Mass Transit Railway, and other public property were routinely destroyed. Nathan Road, a major traffic artery in Kowloon, had all of its traffic lights destroyed. For months, cars and pedestrians had to gingerly traverse this route and its many crossroads to avoid collision or injury. Persons who called for a stop to the violence were beaten in the streets. One man was stoned to death and another, doused with kerosene and set on fire, suffered third-degree burns and lifelong disability as a result. Others were targeted on social media with their personal details exposed. This doxxing, as it is called on the internet, extended to many police officers and public figures who espoused temperate views. The IPCC was caught in this maelstrom of violence.

監警觀點

Viewpoint from IPCC

有鑑自2019年6月12日起投訴數字逐漸攀升,監警會認為以慣常方式逐宗處理投訴個案,已不足以呈現連串事件所造成的全面影響。因此,監警會決定開展專題審視工作,記載事件的發展始末。同時實會方呼籲廣大市民提供資料,務求記錄最全面的實實。監警會即時收錄社交及新聞媒體就事件的報道,亦委託學者進行民意調查,以及向警務人員收集意見,並將兩項研究納入報告中。種種記錄的掌握均有助監警會履行《監警會條例》第8條羅列的職能。

專題審視報告於2020年5月15日發表,包含四冊共 1,000頁文字和圖片。由16個章節組成的專題審視報 告提供了事件的概覽,以及分析公共秩序和使用武 力的相關法例。除了投訴摘要之外,專題審視報告 亦提供六個特定事件日子的詳盡記錄。兩項由獨立 機構進行的研究結果顯示,即便警務人員清楚了解 其職責,並致力維護法紀,仍有為數不少的公眾人 士對警隊失去信任。在結論一章中,監警會向警務 處處長作出52項改善警務程序的建議,以避免或減 少將來出現投訴。

監警會現正繼續監察警方調查2019年6月12日以來 所發生事件的相關投訴。專題審視報告為此提供了 有用的指引。

過去三年累積的經驗,有助監警會跨步向前,繼續 以法定機構的身份監察投訴警方的相關調查。而維 持監察過程的誠信,對重建警民互信至關重要。我 深信監警會在新任主席的領導下,必能承先啟後, 開創更美好的將來。 As the number of complaints began to climb from June 12, 2019, the IPCC decided that the usual case-by-case approach was inadequate to appreciate the full impact of the events as they unfold. Thus, the IPCC decided to conduct the Thematic Study, as it was later called, to chronicle the events as they develop. The IPCC called on the public to provide information so that as full a factual record could be made. Social and news media were recorded in real-time. The IPCC also commissioned two surveys, one of public opinion and one among police officers, to form part of the record. This record would inform the IPCC in discharging its functions under Section 8 of the IPCC Ordinance.

The Thematic Study, published on May 15, 2020, consisted of 4 volumes of text and images, totalling 1000 pages. In 16 Chapters, the Thematic Study provided an overview of the events and an analysis of the laws relating to Public Order and the use of force. In addition to a synopsis of the Complaints received, the Study provided a detailed record of 6 specific incident days. Two surveys by independent parties indicated that while police officers were aware of their duties and were committed to upholding the law, a substantial part of the public had lost trust in the Police Force. In the Concluding Chapter, the IPCC made 52 Recommendations to the Commissioner of Police for improving police procedures to avoid or reduce future complaints.

A core feature of the Thematic Study is the cross-referencing of any fact to verifiable evidence. The IPCC received full support from the Commissioner. I had the privilege of working with many police officers in the course of the past three years. I have found them all professional and passionate in serving the community with honour, duty, and loyalty. I was equally privileged to have worked with many members of the IPCC who brought to the Council a wealth of experience and a great dedication to public service. Last but certainly not least, I was particularly privileged to have worked with the staff of the IPCC and witnessed the immense commitment they brought to their work. After 12 years of experience, the IPCC now has a staff expert in their work. They undoubtedly deserve a clear career path to the top management position. Only when such a structure is in place can any organisation feel confident in facing the future.

The IPCC continues to monitor the police investigations into the complaints made due to the events since June 12, 2109. The Thematic Study has proven to be a helpful guide.

The experience derived from the past three years would help the IPCC go forward as the statutory custodian of investigating complaints against the Police. The integrity of this process is of the highest importance to restoring public trust in the Police. I am sure the IPCC, under the leadership of the new Chairman, will continue to consolidate the achievements of the past and build a better future.


監警會與投訴警察課的聯席會議

在監警會與投訴警察課的聯席會議上,警方簡介了向公眾發佈訊息的情況,並匯報就監警會專題審視報告作出的52項建議的落實進度。會後,時任監警會主席梁定邦博士在宣傳及意見調查委員會主席陳錦榮先生和署理秘書長梅達明先生陪同下會見傳媒,闡述第二十七期《監警會通訊》,以及匯報由大型公眾活動衍生的最新投訴統計數字、投訴警察課提交的調查報告審核進度,以及會方在審核工作中的各項觀察。

At the Joint Meeting between the IPCC and CAPO, the Force gave a presentation on dissemination of information to the public, and updated the progress of follow-up work on the 52 recommendations put forward by the IPCC in its Thematic Study Report. After the Joint Meeting, Dr Anthony Francis Neoh, the then Chairman of the IPCC, accompanied by Mr Clement Chan Kam-wing, Chairman of Publicity and Survey Committee, and Acting Secretary-General Mr Daniel Mui met with the media to introduce the twenty-seventh issue of the *IPCC Newsletter*, and to offer the latest complaints statistics arising from the public order events, the vetting progress of complaint investigation reports submitted by CAPO and the Council's observations while vetting these cases.

In addition to actively raising questions regarding the Council's work, the delegates also shared their experience of complaint handling with regard to legal and law enforcement departments in their respective provincial or municipal governments. The event allowed both parties to deepen their understanding of each other's systems.

與香港青年聯會成員會面 Meeting with members of Hong Kong United Youth Association



繼今年三月監警會在香港青年聯會舉辦的「青年領袖培訓系列-政治及公共行政」培訓課程講課,香港青年聯會主席樓家強先生率領代表團於2021年6月9日回訪監警會。訪問期間,宣傳及意見調查委員會主席陳錦榮先生、委員楊華勇先生,以及署理秘書長梅達明先生介紹了兩層架構投訴警察制度,以及會方的角色和法定職能。代表團亦透過是次訪問,更深入了解監警會的工作。雙方就如何加強在社區宣傳教育,以及持份者聯繫等方面的合作進行了具建設性的討論。



Following the lecture delivered by the IPCC for the Youth Leadership Training Programme organised by the Hong Kong United Youth Association (HKUYA) in March this year, the Chairman of HKUYA, Mr George Lau, led a delegation to pay a reciprocal visit to IPCC on 9 June 2021. During the visit, Mr Clement Chan Kam-wing (Chairman of Publicity and Survey Committee), Council Member Mr Johnny Yu Wah-yung and Acting Secretary-General Mr Daniel Mui gave a presentation on the two-tier police complaints system and the role and statutory functions of the IPCC to the delegation. The visit enabled the delegation to have a better understanding of the work of IPCC and there was fruitful discussion on how to strengthen cooperation between the two organisations in community education and stakeholder engagement.



到訪港島總區指揮及控制中心

Visit to the Regional Command and Control Centre (Hong Kong Island Regional Headquarters)

監警會於2019年大型公眾活動的專題審視報告中,曾就加強999控制中心應對超負荷情況向警方作出了一系列改善建議,並一直密切跟進相關改善建議的落實進度。主席王沛詩女士於2021年6月17日與14名委員以及秘書處代表,在投訴警察課代表的陪同下參觀港島總區指揮及控制中心,並詳細了解999控制中心經優化後的各項措施和人手安排,如何全面加強警隊應對各類緊急情況。





The IPCC put forward a series of recommendations in relation to the enhancement of 999 Console in coping with extreme stress to the Police in its Thematic Study Report on the large-scale public order events in 2019, and has been closely following up on the implementation progress of these recommendations. On 17 June 2021, Council Chairman Ms Priscilla Wong Pui-sze led a delegation comprising 14 Council Members and Secretariat representatives to visit the Regional Command and Control Centre (Hong Kong Island Regional Headquarters). Accompanied by representatives of CAPO, the IPCC delegation examined various enhancements made to the 999 Console as well as manpower deployment and studied how such improvements can fully prepare the Force to handle emergency situations.

Complainants' rights and responsibilities

Complainants' cooperation is essential to the complaint investigation. When exercising their rights to lodge a complaint, the Complainants also have the obligations to provide accurate and comprehensive information as well as valid contact methods so that the two-tier police complaints system can function effectively to facilitate fair and impartial handling of complaint cases, and to ensure justice for both Complainants and Complainees.
