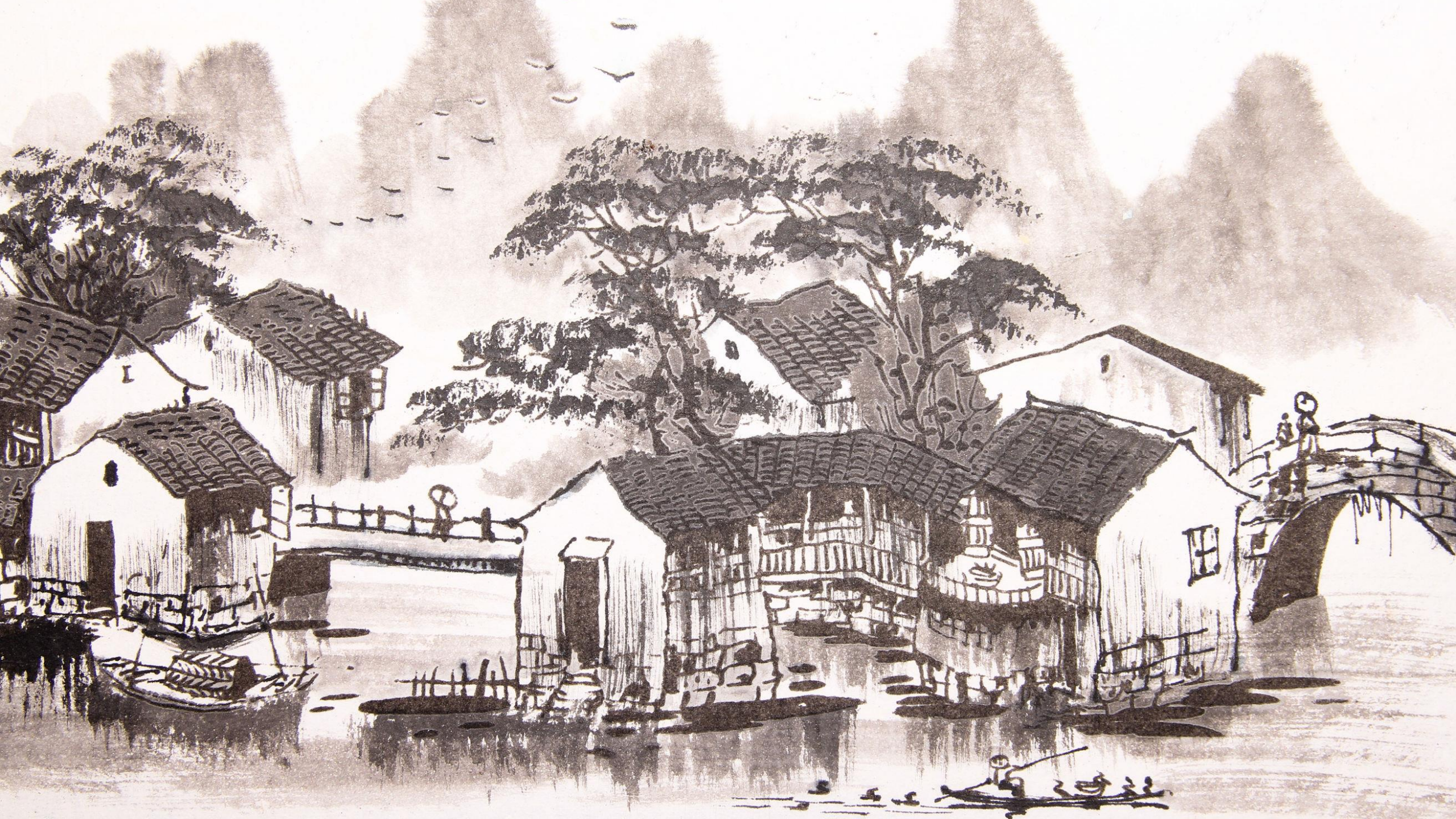

Littering Fixed Penalty \$1,500



亂拋垃圾：包括將垃圾拋入路邊紙盒或竹籬
Littering: including depositing litter into roadside carton boxes or wicker baskets



隨地吐痰：包括吐痰在廢屑箱內或路邊坑渠
Spitting: including spitting into litter container or road gully
